## **SI Amendment**

Section 11 of the Sailing Instructions is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

### **11. Daily Position Reports and Check In**

11.1. **Email Check In.** Each boat that has started shall report her 0700 PDT position by E-mail to [cabocheckin@gmail.com](mailto:cabocheckin@gmail.com) before 0800 PDT each day. To the extent possible, the Communications Officer may E-mail brief acknowledgements of receipt.

11.2. **SAT Phone Check In.** If a boat cannot successfully communicate her position by E-mail, then she must report her position to the Communications Officer by SAT Phone to the following number for her Class:

**Class B: 949-809-9608**

**Class C: 949-809-9609**

**Class D: 949-809-9610**

**Class E: 949-809-9611**

11.3. **Position Report Formats** are Lat/Long, degrees plus minutes to one decimal, as in

This is the vessel "Boat Name" 29 – 25.x N 116 – 32.x W

11.4. **Monitor for Assistance.** All boats are requested to monitor VHF channel 69 between 0700 and 0800 and relay by E-mail or SAT Phone positions or other information for vessels that may have difficulty with E-mail or SAT Phone transmission.

11.5. **Malfunctioning Transponders.** The Communications Officer will attempt to contact by E-mail or SAT Phone boats whose transponder signals are not received by the tracking service. The Communications Officer may request additional position reports at 6 hour intervals from these boats.

11.6. **Weather.** The Communications Officer may request weather information from several boats in each class. Requests will be transmitted by E-mail or SAT Phone between 0700 and 0715 each day. Be prepared to report sea and sky conditions, wind direction (magnetic), wind velocity (true knots), and barometric pressure (millibars) by E-mail or SAT Phone, if asked.

11.7. **Penalties for Failure to Report.** A boat whose position report, or weather report when requested, is not received by the Communications Officer by 0800 by either E-mail, SAT Phone voice message, or relay from another boat, will be protested by the Race Committee and may be penalized up to 30 minutes of elapsed time for each infraction.

11.8. **Standings Reports.** The Communications Officer will E-mail fleet position and handicap standings to each boat each day commencing at 0900 PDT Saturday, March 27, 2010 for boats starting Friday, March 26, 2010, and 0900 PDT Sunday, March 28, 2010 for all boats in all classes or as soon as possible thereafter. **For those without E-mail capabilities, these standings will also be left on a voice mail message by class at the SAT Phone numbers listed in 11.2 above after 0915 PDT.** This report may be moved to an announced later time if there are late reports.
