The organizing authority (OA) for this regatta is held jointly by J Concierge and Balboa Yacht Club.

1 RULES

This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2012), the safety regulations and rules of the individual one design classes and PHRF Southern California class rules for the J/PHRF Class.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to J/24, J/29, J/35, J37, J/80, J44, J/105, J/109, J/111, J/120, J/124 & J/PHRF classes. Five (5) or more boats are required to constitute a one design class. All classes without the sufficient number of boats are invited to participate in the J/PHRF class.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing online registration, via www.balboayachtclub.com, no later than September 14, 2012. Late entries may be accepted with the approval of the OA.
- 2.3 Classes that require crew weigh in shall do so at the place and time listed in Section 4 – Schedule.

3 FEES

The fees for each class are as follows:

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Five (5) one design class races are scheduled to be sailed: Three (3) races on Saturday and two (2) races on Sunday.
- 4.2 Two (2) J/PHRF races are scheduled to be sailed: One (1) race on Saturday and one (1) race on Sunday.
- 4.3 A representative from each boat must check in at Check-In which will be located in the BYC Model Room.

6 VENUE

The racing area will be in the Pacific Ocean in the vicinity of Newport Pier.

7 COURSES

The courses for the one design classes will be windward/leeward in configuration. The courses for the J/PHRF class will be random leg course in configuration.

8 SCORING

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System shall apply except that a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2 and A4.

8.2 For all one design classes, three (3) races will constitute a series.

8.3 For the J/PHRF class, one (1) race will constitute a series.

9 PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded within each class based on the number of boats in that class per the following:
