All members are encouraged to participate in the Balboa Yacht Club Opening Day Ceremonies on Saturday, May 13, 2017. All boat-owning members are especially encouraged to enter their vessels in the Boat Inspection judging and in the Open House Aboard. The space available is limited, so boat entries for Opening Day must be submitted to the BYC Front Office by **April 23 (no exceptions)** and will be accepted by:

- 1) Date and time received at BYC, by class.
- 2) Boats entered for inspection will be given priority if the dock is full.

Copies of the Boat/Food & Beverage judging criteria are available at the BYC Office or online. Inspection begins at 0900 on May 13. Trophies will be awarded to the winners of each of the judging categories listed below. Cocktail & Hors d'oeuvre judging will be 1300 – 1430 hours. To be judged, **all boat owners must be on board** until such time as the inspection team requests privacy or exits the boat.
