



# NOTICE OF RACE

Balboa Yacht Club's  
**Shamrock and Gybe**  
Inside/One Design - March 12, 2016  
Outside/PHRF March 12-13, 2016

## 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), which includes the rules of the classes competing, except that Southern California PHRF MIR Rule (Section 8) shall not apply.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY, CLASSES, AND ENTRY

- 2.1. These events are open to members in good standing of clubs or organizations affiliated with Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA) or any national authority associated with the sport of sailboat racing.
- 2.2. Inside Classes: Harbor 20 (A, B & C), Thistle, Lido 14 (A & B), Finn, Laser, Twichell 12, Adult & Junior Naples Sabot and any other one-design "dinghy" class under 20ft in length with five (5) or more boats entered prior to the day of racing.
- 2.3. Outside Classes: PHRF and one-design keelboat classes 20ft or greater in length with five (5) or more boats entered prior to any day of racing.
- 2.4. Inside Classes Entry Fee: \$20
- 2.5. Outside Classes Entry Fee: \$40 (unless you are entered in the entire 66 Series)
- 2.6. Competitors may enter online at [www.balboayachtclub.com](http://www.balboayachtclub.com), in the "On the Water" section, or by submitting a completed Entry Form and the Entry Fee at the Balboa Yacht Club (BYC) Sailing Office.

## 3. SCHEDULE, NOTICES AND COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. Official notices, including Order of Starts and PHRF Class Breaks, will be posted on BYC's Official Notice Board, located on the Flag Deck, no later than 0900 hours on the day of racing.
- 3.2. Inside Classes Skippers Meeting will be on the BYC Flag Deck at 1200 hours.
- 3.3. Outside Classes Skippers Meeting will be on the BYC Flag Deck at 0930 hours.
- 3.4. The warning signal for the first race for Outside Classes will be at 1200 hours; the warning signal for the first race for Inside Classes will be 1300.
- 3.5. Outside Class competitors shall monitor VHF Channel 69 for communications from the Race Committee.
- 3.6. Two (2) races are scheduled for the Inside Classes.
- 3.7. Three (3) races are scheduled for the Outside Classes. Saturday's races will consist of two (2) buoy races and Sunday will be a pursuit race.

## 4. RACING AREA, COURSE CHARTS, SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, OTHER

- 4.1. Inside Classes: The racing area is primarily inside Newport Harbor with races starting and finishing at the BYC Race Tower.
- 4.2. Outside Classes: The Racing area will take place in the Pacific Ocean. Races start will start/finish in the vicinity of the Newport Pier.
- 4.3. Course Charts and Sailing Instructions will be available at BYC on or before March 11.
- 4.4. Trailer boats equipped with internal lifting slings may launch using BYC hoists. Contact BYC for details.

## 5. SCORING

- 5.1. One (1) completed race shall constitute a series. No scores will be excluded.

## 6. AWARDS

- 6.1. Awards presented at the conclusion of racing each day.
