NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

This regatta will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association. Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

By participating in this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the Organizing Authority and its' sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

DIVISIONS

Lido 14 A, Lido 14 B, and Grand Master (skipper over the age of 60) divisions are offered. The race committee reserves the right to start two or more divisions simultaneously.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

This regatta is open to all boats that meet the following eligibility requirements.

1. The registered skipper is a current member of the Lido 14 Class Association and Fleet One, or is an invited guest of Fleet One.
2. The registered skipper is a current member of a yacht club or sailing organization recognized by US Sailing.

All boats should have a floating bowline of appropriate length.

Each competitor will be responsible for their boat being in compliance with the Class rules.

LOCATION

The official Race Notice Board, registration on the day of the regatta, Competitors' Meeting, protest related events, buffet and awards presentation are all located at Balboa Yacht Club (BYC) which is at 1801 Bayside Drive, Corona del Mar, CA. BYC's telephone number is (949) 673-3515. Races, unless otherwise noted, will be held in the main channel south and west of the BYC Long Dock.

FEES

The entry fee is \$20.00 per boat. The entry fee includes racing, awards, post-racing festivities, and a commemorative Harry Wood Memorial regatta shirt for the skipper and crew (first come, first served – as supplies last).

First Warning at 11:55 AM
No race shall start after 4:00 PM

ENTRY

Competitors may register online at www.balboayachtclub.com, then going to the “On the Water” tab, then to “Online Registration”. Registration and entry fee payment will also be available on the day of the regatta outside the BYC Sailing Office located on the lower level of the BYC clubhouse. Cash and credit card will be accepted.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions and course charts will be available on the day of the regatta at registration.

PENALTIES FOR BREAKING RULES OF PART 2 - Appendix P

Immediate penalties are modified to be one 360 degree turn consisting of one tack and one gybe.

SCORING

The RRS Low Point Scoring System shall apply except that if fewer than four (4) races are completed, a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2. Four (4) races are scheduled. Three (3) completed races shall constitute a series.

FACILITIES

The hospitality of BYC and its’ facilities, except on-site automobile parking, are extended to all competitors. On-site trailer parking is provided. Boats are launched at BYC via a hoist; boats must be equipped with an internal lifting sling.

SAFETY

A US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device is strongly encouraged to be worn, properly fastened, at all times while launching and when sailing. A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course. All support people on the water (race committee, mark and safety boat operators, parents, etc.) are strongly encouraged to wear PFDs.

TROPHIES

Perpetual trophies will be awarded for first place in each division. Take home trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew for the top three (3) boats in the A and B divisions and the top boat in the Grand Master division. District Champs trophies will be handed out per the class bylaws.
