



## Boat Usage- Priority Guidelines

BYC has put together the following policy regarding boat delegation and priority:

1. Member/Member (in class)
2. Member/Non-Member (in class)
3. \*Member/Member (not enrolled)
4. \*Member/Non-Member (not enrolled)
5. Non-Member/Non-Member (in class)
6. \*Non-Member/Non-Member (not enrolled)

**“In class” definition- registered and actively participating in a current BYC Junior Sailing Program season (fall, winter, spring, summer)**

\*Subject Boat Charter fee

**How to reserve a boat:**

- Boats will be reserved on a first come/first served basis
  - To request a boat for each regatta, **sailors** must email Junior Sailing Director and the Head Coach
- Skipper/crew must be registered for the event prior to request of a boat
- Skipper and crew must be confirmed by Junior Sailing Director prior to boat selection
- It is the responsibility of the **sailors** to communicate to the Junior Sailing Director what boat they would ideally like to use

**How boats will get assigned by Junior Sailing Director and Head Coach:**

- Class hierarchy (most advanced to the intro class) with the boat delegation and priority list, along with demonstrated skill-level will be considered when Junior Sailing Director assigns boats for a regatta
- You will receive a confirmation email from Junior Sailing Director with your boat assignment
- Boat assignments are at the discretion of the Junior Sailing Director
- The decision of the Junior Sailing Director or Head Coach, respectively, shall be final
